Introduction	The Belt and Road Summit brings together senior government officials, representatives of international institutions, business leaders and industry experts from countries and regions along and beyond the Belt and Road to exchange views on multilateral co-operation and explore new business opportunities arising from the Belt and Road Initiative. The eighth edition in 2023 featured 99 heavyweight speakers and gathered close to 6,000 participants from more than 70 countries and regions. Over 800 one-to-one business matching meetings involving over 280 projects were arranged during the event. These encouraging turnouts are solid evidences demonstrating the Summit's status as a preferred platform for companies to do Belt and Road businesses in the post-pandemic era and the keen global interest in Belt and Road related opportunities.

providers. The deal-making session had been extended to a total of 6 days, with 2-day on-site meetings (13-14 Sept) and 4 days digital extension until 20 Sept 2023.

Under the themes of “Innovation and Technology”, “Transport and Logistics Infrastructure”, “Energy, Natural Resources & Public Utilities”, “Urban Development” and three Middle East-focused sessions, project owners from around the world showcased their project ventures in the thematic Project Investment Sessions. Through one-to-one business matching meetings, Summit participants met with potential business partners based on their shared areas of interest through pre-arranged meetings. The 2023 Summit showcased more than **280** investment projects and arranged over **800** one-to-one business matching meetings for project owners, investors and services providers.
